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DOWNHILL

Course inspection: 9:00 to 9:30 a.m.

Race Start time: 9:30 a.m.

Run order will be by bib number. Pre-registration entry determines the order in age bracket. Bib number will be pre-assigned. The Bib number assigned will be used for the whole day. Bibs must be turned back in at the end of the day of racing. Oldest age runs first, women and men; then the next younger age bracket women and men and so on. All racers registering on race day run at the end on a first come basis.

Course: Start top of Stinger (Chicken Point) down to the Ted Lepkowicz Deck across to Canyon, down to Canyon all the way to the finish by Chair #1.

Rules: All control gates must be completed, one single run time. If a racer falls he/she can only complete the course if both skis stay on. Helmets are required. Fastest time wins.

GIANT SLALOM

Race Start Time: 10:30 a.m.

Run Order: by approximate bib number.

Course: Start mid station racing hut Gunbarrel #9. Terrain and length of course is similar to NASTAR course. Dual Course- one run on each course with the best run counting.

Rules: All gates must be completed. If a ski falls off, a racer can complete the course only if two gates from the finish. Racer has to have one ski on to cross the finish. Fastest single run time wins.

CROSS COUNTRY

Race Start Time: 11:30

Run Order: first come first serve basis.

Course: Start at Base Lodge headed west across base area past Rental Building, then up lower loop towards the Sunnyside chair onto upper loop, then down Little Joe and back across the base area to finish. Two person staggered start- timed run. Distance: ½ mile loop. Participants will take two laps around the loop for a distance of 1 mile.

Rules: Any kind of cross-country skis are acceptable. Racer must bring own equipment- no rentals available. This is an open race (skating allowed). Fastest time wins, one run.

SNOWSHOE

Race Start Time: 11:45 a.m.

Run Order: first come first serve basis.

Course: Two people run at one time. Course 100 ft. down and 100 ft. back, flat terrain -fastest time wins, one run.

Rules: Fastest time wins. Snowshoes will be provided.

LUNCH

Time: 12:30 to 2:00 p.m.

Menu: Stuffed Capon with Baked Potato, Peas and Carrots, Rolls and Butter, Bottled Water- Coffee, Dessert

AWARDS CEREMONY

Time: 1:00 p.m.

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each age bracket per each event.

ATHLETE'S WAIVER, PLEDGE AND CONSENT AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry into the competition known as the Connecticut Senior Winter Games, I, intending to be legally bound, do hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and forever discharge any and all rights and claims for damages, including any claims for loss, damages or injury to my person or property arising out of the performance or failure of performance of the State of Connecticut, the Connecticut Senior Games, the Nutmeg State Games, any and all sponsors, groups providing sanction or approval, owners of the sites, and/or the respective officer/agents, representatives, successors and/or assigns of the parties named above for any and all claims for damage to person or property sustained by me in connection with, association or entry in, and/or arising from activity related to the Connecticut Senior Games. I have full knowledge that the sport in which I have entered carries significant risk of personal injury, in some cases very severe injury, even death. I also agree that I am responsible for my own safety. I declare that to the best of my knowledge, I am in good physical condition and have no disease or injury that would be aggravated by my participation in activities related to the Connecticut Senior Games.

I, also, declare on my honor that I am an amateur and fulfill the conditions stipulated by the Connecticut Senior Games. I agree that if I am selected for competition at the Finals of the Games, I will compete in the Games, keep myself in top physical condition, retain my amateur status and make myself available for training wherever and whenever possible. I will also appear and participate in the Opening Ceremonies and report to the press tent for pictures, interviews, as directed by Connecticut Senior Games authorities.

I hereby consent to allow my picture or likeness to appear in any official documentary, sponsor advertisement or exclusive television coverage of the Connecticut Senior Olympics in any manner incidental to my participation in the Connecticut Senior Olympics and without compensation to me. I declare that I have personal medical coverage and that I have read all of the above and understand the release waiver, and by signing it agree to all its items.

BY ENTERING AND PARTICIPATING IN THE CONNECTICUT SENIOR GAMES, ALL ATHLETES AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES, REGULATIONS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION OF THE GAMES' ADMINISTRATORS.
