Competition Info:

Shooting Distances: 60 yds, 50 yds & 40 yds. Competition will consist of 90 arrows shot as follows: 30 arrows from 60 yards; 30 arrows from 50 yards; and 30 arrows from 40 yards. Awards will be presented for 1st through 3rd place for each event within each age division. Recurve archery events will be conducted in accordance with National Archery Association rules, except as modified herein. Compound archery events will be conducted in accordance with National Field Archery Association rules, except as modified herein.

Age Groups:

50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

Age Cut off Date:

Your age division / group will be determined by your age as of December 31, 2010. If you are turning 50 in the calendar year of 2010, you are eligible to compete in the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games!

2010 Archery Rules:

- ? All first-, second-, third- and fourth-place winners as well as athletes meeting this sport's NSGA minimum performance standards in competition at the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games will qualify for the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.

Traveling WEST:

On route 84, take Exit 63 (which says South Windsor).
As you follow the exit, stay to the right through the yield sign.

At the second light, take a right onto Oakland Street.
After going through the second light and over the railroad tracks, this becomes Summit Street.

When you reach the traffic light, take a left onto East Middle Turnpike.
Make a right onto Brookfield St.
