- ? Only athletes meeting this sport's NSGA minimum performance standards in competition at the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games will qualify for the 2011 Summer National Senior Games. Qualifiers will be determined by 18-hole gross score played on a course with a minimum par of 70 and a United States Golf Association (USGA) slope rating between 119 and 126 for men and between 113 and 120 for women.

From Springfield, MA:

Take I-91 S entering Connecticut. Take exit 35A to merge onto I-291 E toward Manchester. Take the exit onto I-384 E. Take exit 3 for CT-83 S. Turn left at CT-83 S/S Main St. Destination will be on the left.

From Providence, RI:

Take US-6 W entering Connecticut. Merge onto US-6 W via the ramp to Willimantic/Hartford. Slight right toward US-6 W/Willimantic Rd. Continue straight onto US-6 W/Willimantic Rd. Continue to follow US-6 W. Continue onto I-384 W. Take exit 3 toward CT-83/Downtown/Glastonbury/Manchester. Turn left at Charter Oak St. Turn left at CT-83 S/S Main St.

From Danbury:

Take I-84 E/US-202 E/US-6 E/US-7 N via the ramp to Waterbury/New Milford. Continue to follow I-84 E. Take exit 59 to merge onto I-384 E toward Providence. Take exit 3 for CT-83 S. Turn left at CT-83 S/S Main St.

From New Haven:

Take I-91 N. Take exit 29 to merge onto CT-15 N/US-5 N toward I-84 E/E Hartford/Boston. Continue onto CT-15 N. Merge onto I-84 E. Take exit 59 to merge onto I-384 E toward Providence. Take exit 3 for CT-83 S. Turn left at CT-83 S/S Main St.
