## **Competition Info:**

Play may be round robin or double elimination depending upon entry. Age groups may be combined to provide opportunity for play. Awards will be presented for 1st through 3rd place for each event within each age division. Athletes must provide their own racquets. Balls will be provided. All matches will be conducted in accordance with United States Racquetball Association rules, except as modified herein. Eye protection is required for all athletes participating in racquetball.

## **Age Groups:**

50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

## **Age Cut off Date:**

Your age division / group will be determined by your age as of December 31, 2010. If you are turning 50 in the calendar year of 2010, you are eligible to compete in the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games!

## **Qualifying Rules:**

- ? All first-, second-, third- and fourth-place winners at the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games will qualify for the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
- ? Athletes must qualify in each racquetball event (singles, doubles) in which they wish to compete at the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
- ? Matches will be best of three games, with the first to games to 15. Third game tiebreakers will be played to 11.

### **From Merritt Parkway/Rte.15 North:**

Exit 63. At end of ramp, take right onto Clintonville Rd./Rte.22. At first light, take right onto State St. and follow to first stop sign. Take left onto Broadway at stop sign and follow under overpass. First right after overpass is Elm St. We are at 100 Elm, quarter mile down on the right.

**From Merritt Parkway/Rte.15 South:**

Exit 63. At end of ramp, take left onto Hartford Turnpike. At first light take immediate left onto Clintonville Rd./Rte.22. (crossing back over highway) At second light, take right onto State St. and follow to first stop sign. Take left onto Broadway at stop sign and follow under overpass. First right after overpass is Elm St. We are at 100 Elm, quarter mile down on right.

**From Interstate 91 North:**

Take Exit 11 ramp and stay to right. At first light, take right on Washington Ave. At next light, take right on Broadway. First left off Broadway is Elm St. We are at 100 Elm, quarter mile down on right.

**From Interstate 95 North/South:**

Take exit for Interstate 91 north and follow directions immediately above.

**From Interstate 91 South:**

Take Exit 12 and take left off ramp onto Washington Ave. Follow down through five traffic lights. At six light, take right onto Broadway. First left off Broadway is Elm St.. We are at 100 Elm, quarter mile down on right.

**National Senior Games – Houston, TX:**
