Table Tennis Info:

Play may be round robin or double elimination depending upon entry. Age groups may be combined to provide opportunity for play. The tournament will be played best of 5 games for groups of 4 or more, best of 7 games for groups of 3 or less in each age group. Awards will be presented for 1st through 3rd place for each division within each age group. Players must provide their own paddles. Balls will be provided. All matches will be conducted in accordance with USA Table Tennis rules, except as modified herein.

Qualifying Rules:

1. All first-, second-, third- and fourth-place winners at the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games will qualify for the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
2. Athletes must qualify in each table tennis event (singles, doubles, and mixed doubles) in which they wish to compete at the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
3. Players must provide their own paddles. Balls will be provided.
4. The age division of competition for doubles will be determined by the younger age of the two partners as of December 31, 2011.

Age Groups: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

Age Cut off Date: Your age division / group will be determined by your age as of December 31, 2010. If you are turning 50 in the calendar year of 2010, you are eligible to compete in the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games!

Directions – Riverview Hospital – Middletown, CT

915 River Rd. Middletown, CT 06457

From Hartford:

I-91 South to Route 9 (left hand exit) and then to Middletown. Take Silver Street, Exit and turn left off ramp over Route 9. Follow Silver Street to end, which becomes River Road. Continue on River Road then turn right on Riverview Drive and look for parking signs.

From Route 9 North to Middletown:

Take Eastern Drive Exit to right. Follow Eastern Drive to Silver Street, turn right on Silver Street to end, which becomes River Road. Continue on River Road then turn right on Riverview Drive and look for parking signs.

From Route 9 of Wilbur Cross:

Take Route 9 North to Rte 66, Meriden-Middletown Exit. Right on Route 66 (becomes Washington Street in Middletown) to juncture with Route 9 at Connecticut River. Turn right on Route 9 to Silver Street Exit and follow instructions under Hartford, above.

From Routes 66 and 6A:

Routes 66 & 6A southeast to Middletown via Portland Bridge. Follow signs off bridge to Route 9 (left around rotary and right down under railroad tracks). Right on Route 9 to Silver Street. Exit and follow instructions under Hartford above.

MAIN DIRECTIONS - at the Riverview Hospital: Make a right into the Riverview hospital main entrance Follow the signs to the School-West Building (Take the third right from the main drive) Park in front of the School in it's parking lot - The gym is behind the 'School-West' building, Walk around the right side on the sidewalk to the separate gym doors in the right rear of the school - the main school doors are usually locked during our activities.

National Senior Games – Houston, TX:

The 2010 Connecticut Senior Games are a qualifier event for the National Senior Games which will take place June 16th – 30th, 2011 in Houston, TX.
