Tournament Info:

Play may be round robin or double elimination depending upon entry. Age groups may be combined to provide opportunity for play. Manchester High School features 4 tennis courts. Awards will be presented for 1st through 3rd place for each division within each age group. Matches shall consist of two sets using regular scoring. Ties will be broken in accordance with USTA rules governing tie-breakers. All matches will be conducted in accordance with United States Tennis Association (USTA) rules, except as modified herein.

Qualifying Rules:

1. All first-, second- and third-place winners at the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games will qualify for the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
2. Athletes must qualify in each tennis event (singles, doubles, mixed doubles) in which they wish to compete at the 2011 Summer National Senior Games.
3. The age division of competition for doubles will be determined by the lower age of the two partners as of December 31, 2010.
4. Athletes must provide their own racquets and practice balls.

Age Groups:

50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90+

Age Cut off Date:

Your age division / group will be determined by your age as of December 31, 2010. If you are turning 50 in the calendar year of 2010, you are eligible to compete in the 2010 Connecticut Senior Games!

Directions – Manchester High School Tennis Courts– Manchester, CT

Manchester High School 134 East Middle Turnpike Manchester, CT 06040

*Tennis Event participants must park either on East Center Street or in the Manchester High parking lot and walk (about 300 yards) to the tennis courts behind the softball fields. Tennis participants may not park in the doctor's office parking lot off East Center Street.

From Springfield, MA:

Take I-91 S entering Connecticut. Take exit 30 on the left to merge onto I-84 E toward CT-2/E Hartford/New London. Take the US-6/US-44/Middle Turnpike W exit. Turn right at Middle Turnpike W/US-44 E/US-6 E. Continue to follow US-44 E/US-6 E. Please park on East Center Street.

From Providence, RI:

Take US-6 W entering Connecticut. Merge onto US-6 W via the ramp to Willimantic/Hartford. Take slight right toward US-6 W/Willimantic Rd. Continue straight onto US-6 W/Willimantic Rd. Continue to follow US-6 W. Take the US-6 W/US-44 W/Bolton exit. Slight right at Boston Turnpike/US-44 W/US-44 Alt W/US-6 W. Continue to follow US-44 W/US-44 Alt W/US-6 W. Please park on East Center Street.

From Danbury:

Take I-84 E/US-202 E/US-6 E/US-7 N via the ramp to Waterbury/New Milford. Continue to follow I-84 E. Take the US-6/US-44/Middle Turnpike W exit. Turn right at Middle Turnpike W/US-44 E/US-6 E. Continue to follow US-44 E/US-6 E. Please park on East Center Street.

From New Haven:

Take I-91 North. Take exit 29 to merge onto CT-15 N/US-5 N toward I-84 E/E Hartford/Boston. Continue onto CT-15 N. Merge onto I-84 E. Take the US-6/US-44/Middle Turnpike W exit. Turn right at Middle Turnpike W/US-44 E/US-6 E. Continue to follow US-44 E/US-6 E. Please park on East Center Street.
